Master Xu began studying martial arts in 1966 in Shanghai, China. A dedicated martial artist, Master Xu specializes in Chen style Tai Chi, Hsing Yi, and Lan Shou. He has distinguished himself in tournaments in the U.S. and China as a **gold medalist**. The International Kung Fu Federation awarded him with the **World Cup Championship in 1987**. He is the author of over fifty articles for U.S. and foreign publications and has written two books, one on Hsing Yi and the other on Lan Shou.

Currently living and teaching in San Francisco, Master Xu spends much of his time as a **featured instructor at workshops and camps throughout North America and Europe**. Master Xu often says that there is no end to learning. His own practice and study, along with his eagerness to share his knowledge, makes him one of the most exciting and respected teachers in martial arts today.
